



Multi-Sibling Discount:

Discount applies to 8 week (full day) camp registrations for all same household siblings. After first sibling 8 week (full day) camp registration is paid, each additional same-household sibling will receive \$40 off their 8 week (full day) camp registration. Discount does not apply to those siblings not residing in the same household, 2 and/or 4 week registration, BEFORE Camp, AFTER Camp, and/or BEFORE and AFTER Camp registration.

Please Note:
